

Minister of Tourism, Honorable Ibrahim Faisal Officially Inaugurates Sustainable Tourism Forum 2023



At the Manhattan Business Hotel in Male', IMTM Pvt. Ms. Aishath Fara, the Events Manager, initiated the forum by celebrating the milestone achievement of submitting the policy brief from 2022 to relevant authorities, emphasizing IMTM's dedication to advocating for sustainable tourism practices. Stressing the essence of Sustainable Tourism Forum 2023, Ms. Fara expressed, "Our primary objective for Sustainable Tourism Forum 2023 is to pinpoint strategies to refine the tourism sector and establish customized sustainability benchmarks tailored specifically for the Maldives' tourism industry."

Highlighting the importance of 'Green Investments' such as sustainable infrastructure, renewable energy, and innovative practices, Ms. Fara articulated, "These investments align with the fundamental principles of responsible tourism, aiming to minimize environmental impact, support local economies, and preserve cultural authenticity, thereby anchoring a sustainable and conscientious tourism industry crucial for its continuous advancement."

During the ceremony, Mr. Enrico Gaveglia commended the Ministry's initiatives in promoting sustainable practices. IMTM Successfully Concludes the Fourth Edition of Sustainable Tourism Forum

It provided an opportunity to delve into how tourism investments in upskilling people, renewable energy, and climate adaptation, while fostering avenues for innovation and entrepreneurship, could lead to a more sustainable future in an ever-changing world.

The Sustainable Tourism Forum garnered official endorsements from: the Ministry of Tourism as the Official Partner, the Maldives Marketing & Public Relations Corporation (MMPRC) as the Official Destination Partner, and the Maldives Association of Tourism Industry (MATI) as the Endorsing Partner.

The forum brought together various stakeholders from the tourism sector, including resorts, guesthouses, and NGOS, as well as private sector tourism-related businesses, independent institutions, UNDP, ministries, scientific and academic bodies. It encouraged a multi-sector conversation and collaboration towards a common goal: sustainability.

Sustainable Tourism Forum 2023 aimed to gain insight into the tourism sector stakeholders' understanding of sustainability and how they practice it. With this goal, STF endeavored to define sustainable tourism establishments in the country. The primary objective of the STF was to identify and develop criteria for sustainable tourism establishments in the Maldives. A policy paper detailing the findings and recommendations from the forum will be published, with hopes of bolstering sustainability in the Maldives. This paper will be presented to government offices, NGOs, associations, and other tourism-related establishments.

Maldives Signs USD 50 Million 'Urban Isle' Project with China



China's Hunan Construction Investment Group has secured the contract to construct seven architecturally innovative buildings, designed to mimic a "spine" as part of the Urban Isle project in Hulhumale.

Accompanying President Dr. Mohamed Muizzu on his State Visit to China, Ibrahim Fazul Rasheed, Managing Director of Urbanco, signed the agreement, aiming to enhance tourism and employment opportunities in the greater Male' area."

The USD 50 million project aims to integrate three to four-story buildings over 290,000 square feet. These structures will host tourism boutiques, hotels, banking services, wellness facilities, retail shops, and various entertainment options, forming a cohesive hub to enhance the tourism experience.

Urbanco highlights the MVR 771 million (USD 50 million) estimated cost, emphasising the project's importance for the Maldives' economy, with the "spine" concept reflecting the interconnectedness of buildings, both physically and in activities. The Urban Isle project, set to become the Maldives' largest commercial hub, will create business opportunities, spur economic growth, and boost employment for regional prosperity.

Maldives Achieves Highest Ever Tourist Arrivals with Over 1.8 Million Tourists in 2023



The Maldives has today welcomed our 1.8 millionth tourist for the year 2023, successfully reaching the arrival target set for the year. Maldives Marketing and Public Relations Corporation (MMPRC/ Visit Maldives) held a vibrant ceremony today to mark the momentous occasion. We reached this incredible milestone on December 20th, 2023 with the arrival of Dutch native Mr Stefan Mathijs Hermans on fight EK652 from Dubai, UAE. This is Mr Hermans' first trip to the Maldives and he is here for a family holiday with his wife and two children. This is the first year that the Maldives has ever welcomed over 1.8 million tourists and marks our highest arrival numbers to date.

MMPRC hosted the special celebratory event at Velana International Airport to commemorate this momentous milestone, joined by representatives from the Ministry of Tourism, Maldives Airports Company Limited (MACL), Maldives Immigration, and Maldives Customs Service. The Minister of Tourism, Honourable Ibrahim Faisal joined the event today in addition to the Chief Executive Officer and Managing Director (CEO & MD) of MMPRC, Ms Fathmath Thaufeeq. The CEO & MD of MACL, Mr Ibrahim Shareef Mohamed, the Head of the Airport Division, Principal Immigration Officer of Maldives Immigration, Ms Fathimath Majidha Hassan, and the Deputy Commissioner of Customs, Mr Mahmood Riyaz also joined the event celebrating this landmark achievement.
